# *Beanie Sizes Guide*



# Material Needed

## MATERIAL NEEDED

tapestry needle, sentro or addi machine

## YARN

60 gr to 120 gr  
DK acrylic yarn 100gr and 250m

## SIZES

Head baby to man size

## GAUGE

4" or 10 cm = 14 st x 23 Rows

# Instructions

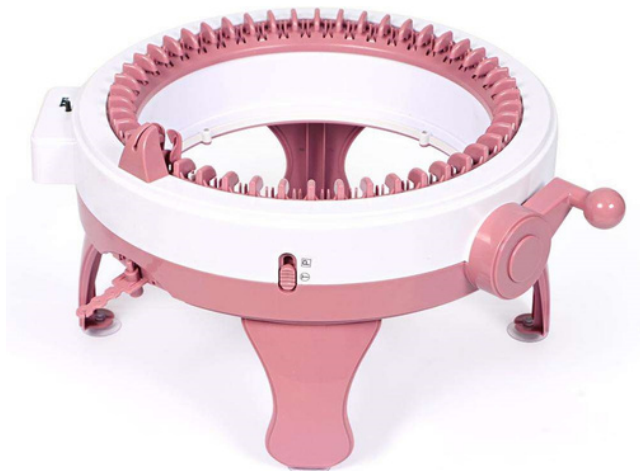
I made this quick guide to help beginners to learn how to use the circular knitting machines.

When you first start working with a circular knitting machine, chances are your first project will be a Beanie.

So what are the sizes that you can make on each knitting machine, and how much yarn are you going to use for each size.

I put on the table of the last page the machine sizes for each size of beanie, but it's pretty simple, if you want smaller beanies you should get a Sentro 40, if you want only for adults you should get the Sentro 48.

# Instructions

## KNITTED TUBE

To make a Beanie there's no mystery, it's just cast on the stitches weaving the yarn on the front of 1 needle and on the back of the 2nd and repeat around, after the last needle, place the yarn inside the yarn guide, then the tension guide and crank the machine until you have the right number of rows for the desired size.

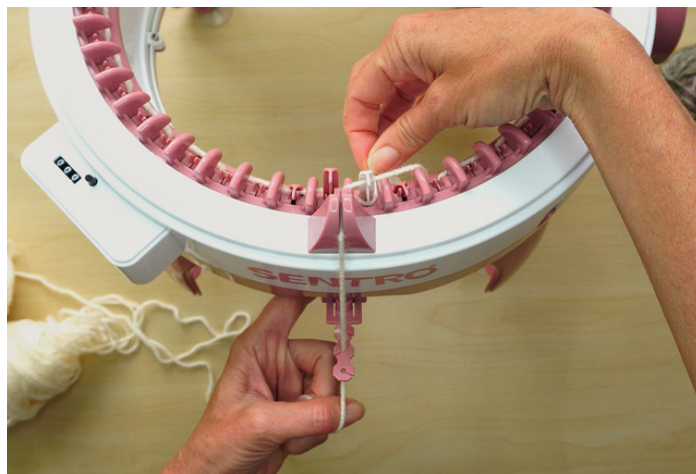
After that, make one full row without yarn to release the stitches from the hooks and remove all the stitches with the tail and a tapestry needle that comes with the machines.

After you grab all the loops, remove the needle and pull the yarn to cinch until is closed. With the tapestry needle make a few knots and put inside the rest of the tube joining both ends, close the other side and pass both tails to the top to make another knot.

Hide the tails and cut it, make a pom pom to match with the Brim.

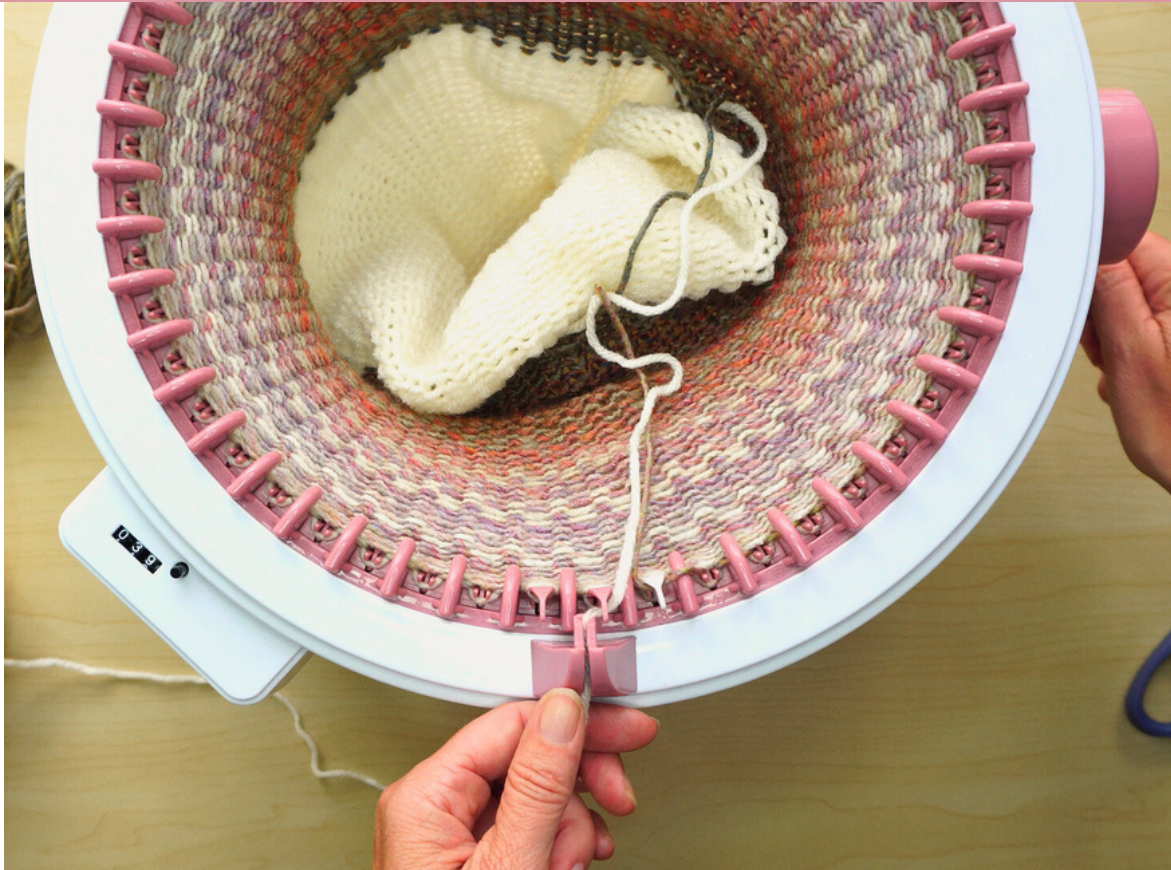


First row

## CHANGING COLORS

If you want a different Brim color you need to divide the total size of your beanie rows by 3. For example, for a woman you need 120 rows, so you will make 40 rows white, 40 rows red and another 40 white, this way you will have a red brim.

To change colors, stop cranking on needle 1, cut the yarn in use and remove from the yarn guide placing it on top of your beanie inside the machine.

Place the next yarn tail in front of the very next needle and inside the yarn guide and tension guide and start working with the new color.

Before you close the beanie on both ends make a knot on every tail of the color change to make sure your work won't open after cinched.

10 - 13 Yo	Sentro 48 or Addi 46	100 - 110	8'   24 cm	18' - 46 cm	6.5' - 16 cm	80 gr
Adult woman	Sentro 48	120 - 130	8.5'   21 cm	22' - 58 cm	6.5' - 16 cm	90 gr
Adult man	Sentro 48	140	9.5'   24 cm	26' - 66 cm	6.5' - 16 cm	100 gr

- for no Brim reduce 20 rows from the total
